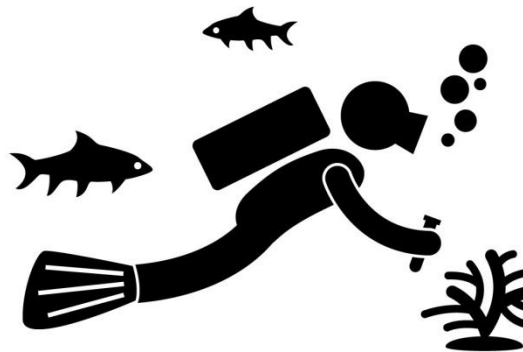

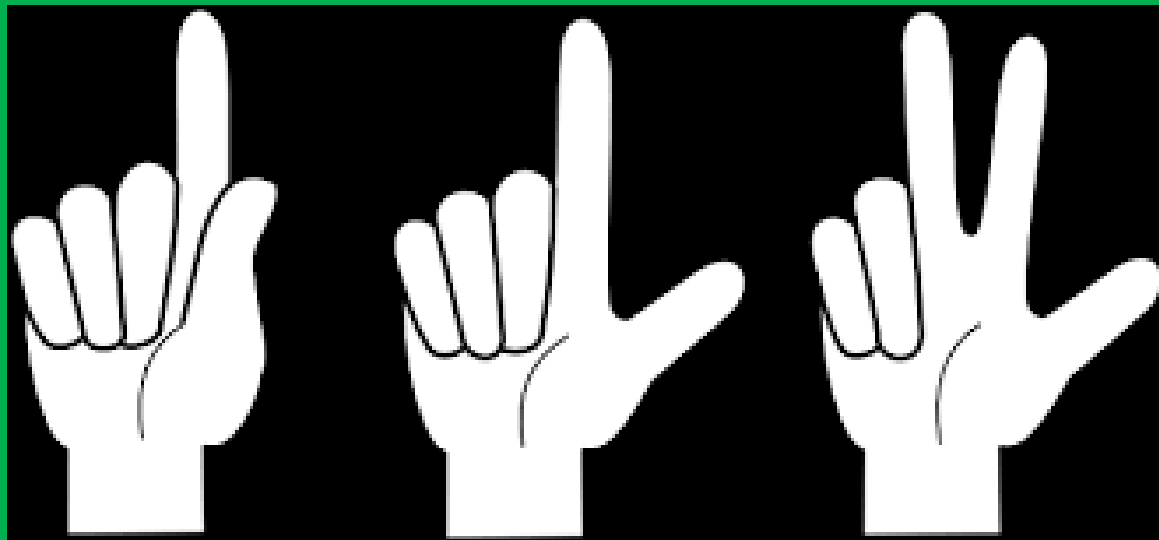

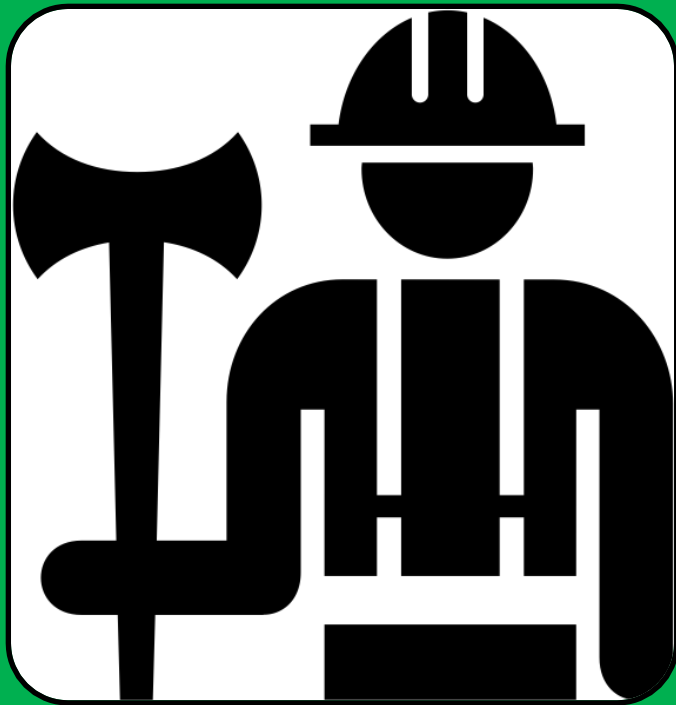

Only a fraction of what remains is old-growth forest. Forested lands continue to come back slowly, but it is well below the pace needed. To reach a net-zero emission economy by mid-century,

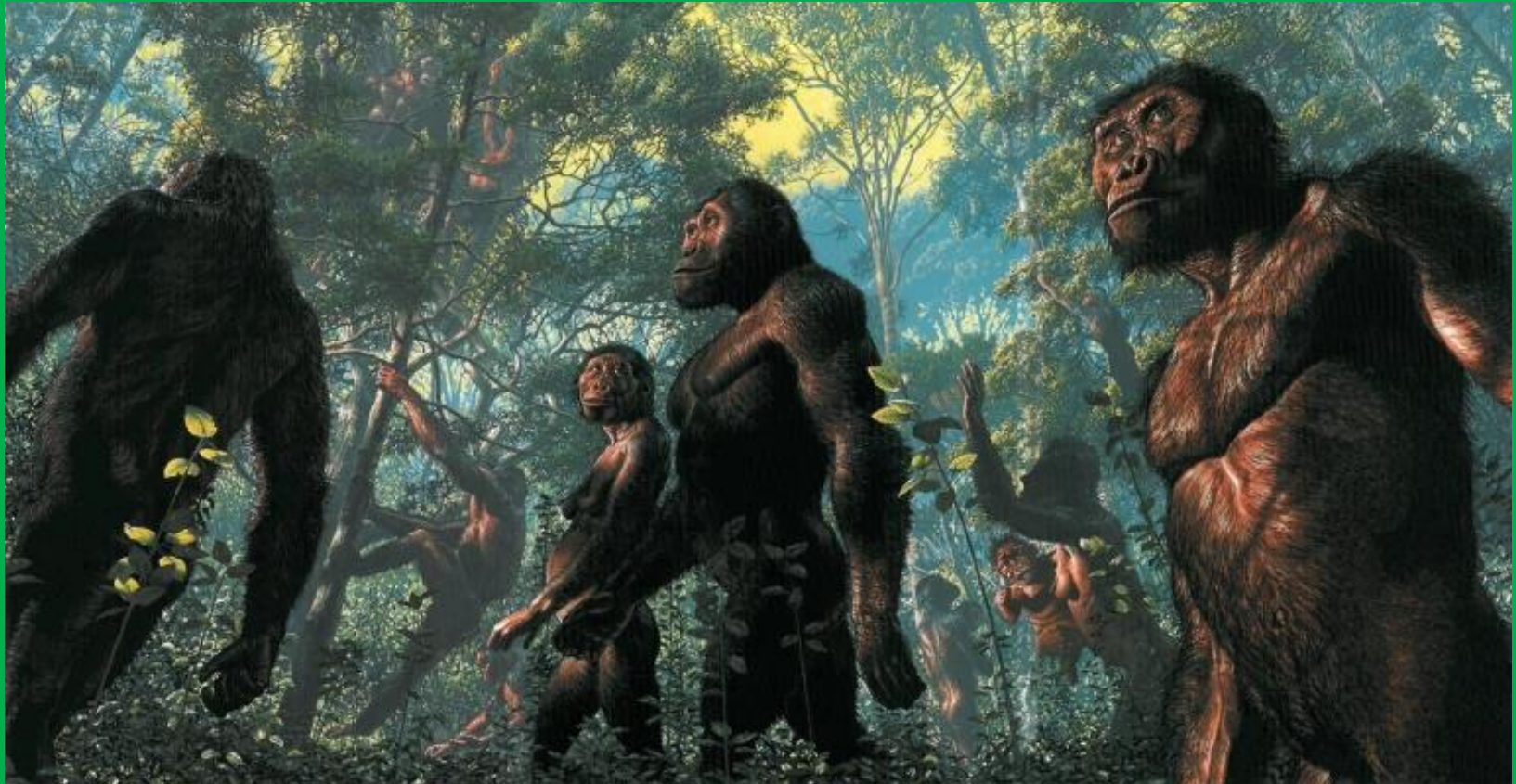
we must reforest land—in other words, the remaining emissions our economy still creates are canceled out by the emissions absorbed by land. Similarly, **many forests are badly in need of restoration, threatened by drought, wildfire, and invasive species, which are only exacerbated by climate change.**

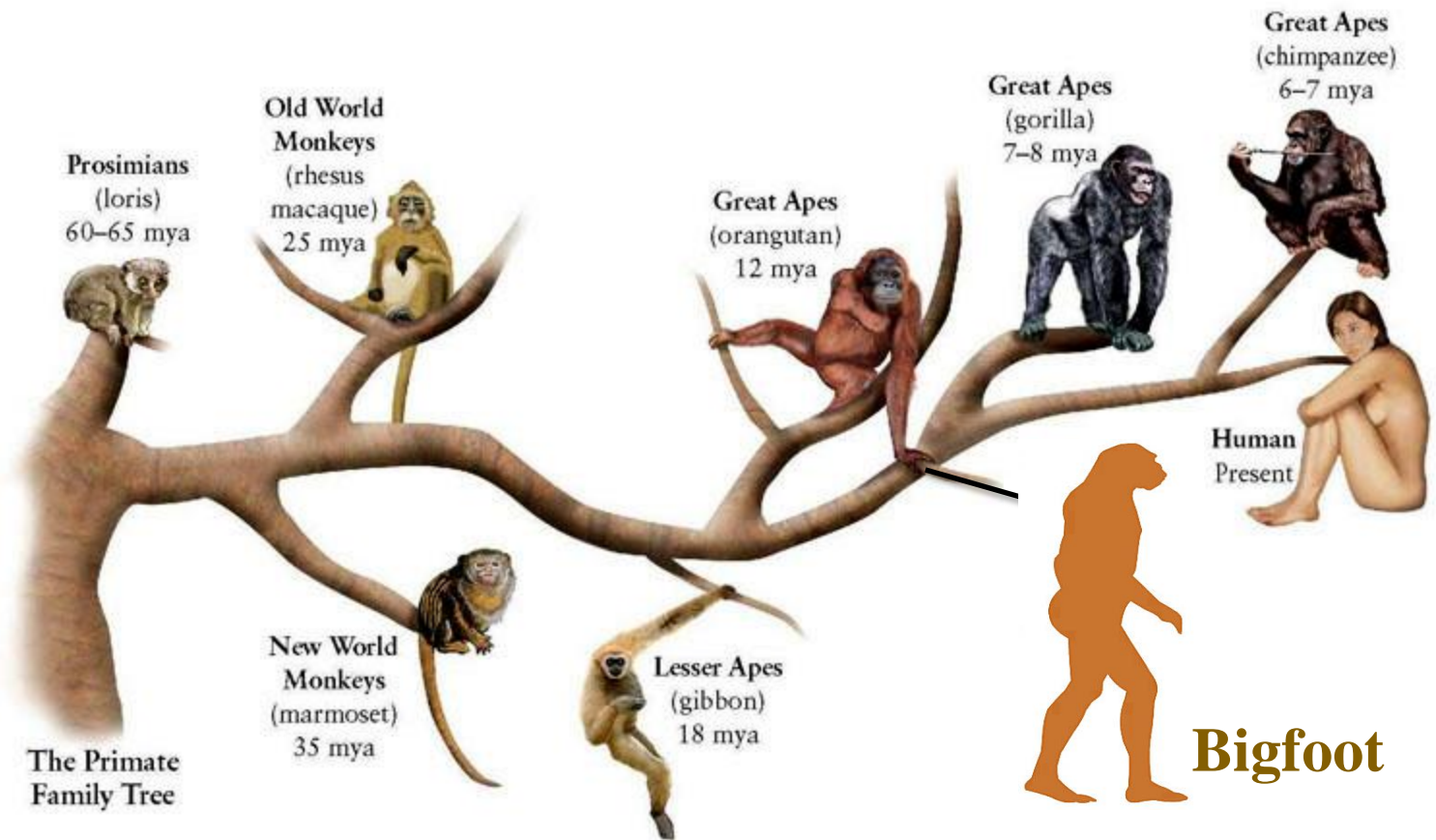
Expanding forests by 40-50 million acres by 2035 could achieve **reductions of 600 million tons of carbon dioxide** equivalent by 2050. With forests as part of a holistic plan, the full land carbon sink **could offset up to 45 percent of economy-wide emissions annually** by 2050.

Miocene Hominoids

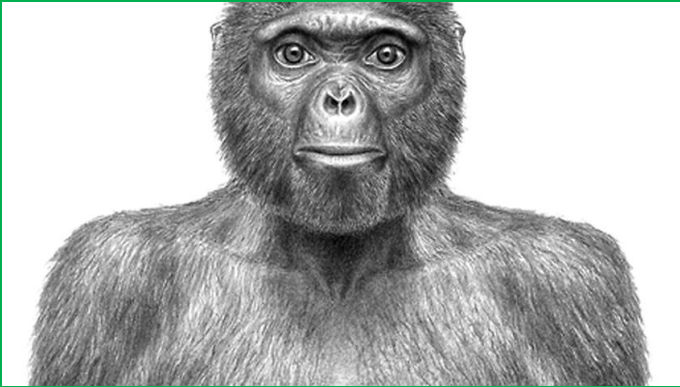
The foundation was laid for the life, climate, and geography of the modern world, ending around 5M years ago.

Many species of land mammals evolved during this period, such as the dog, cats, horses, bears, deer, elephants, etc. The apes first evolved, arose, and diversified during the early Miocene, becoming widespread in the Old World. 95% of modern plants existed by the end of this epoch.

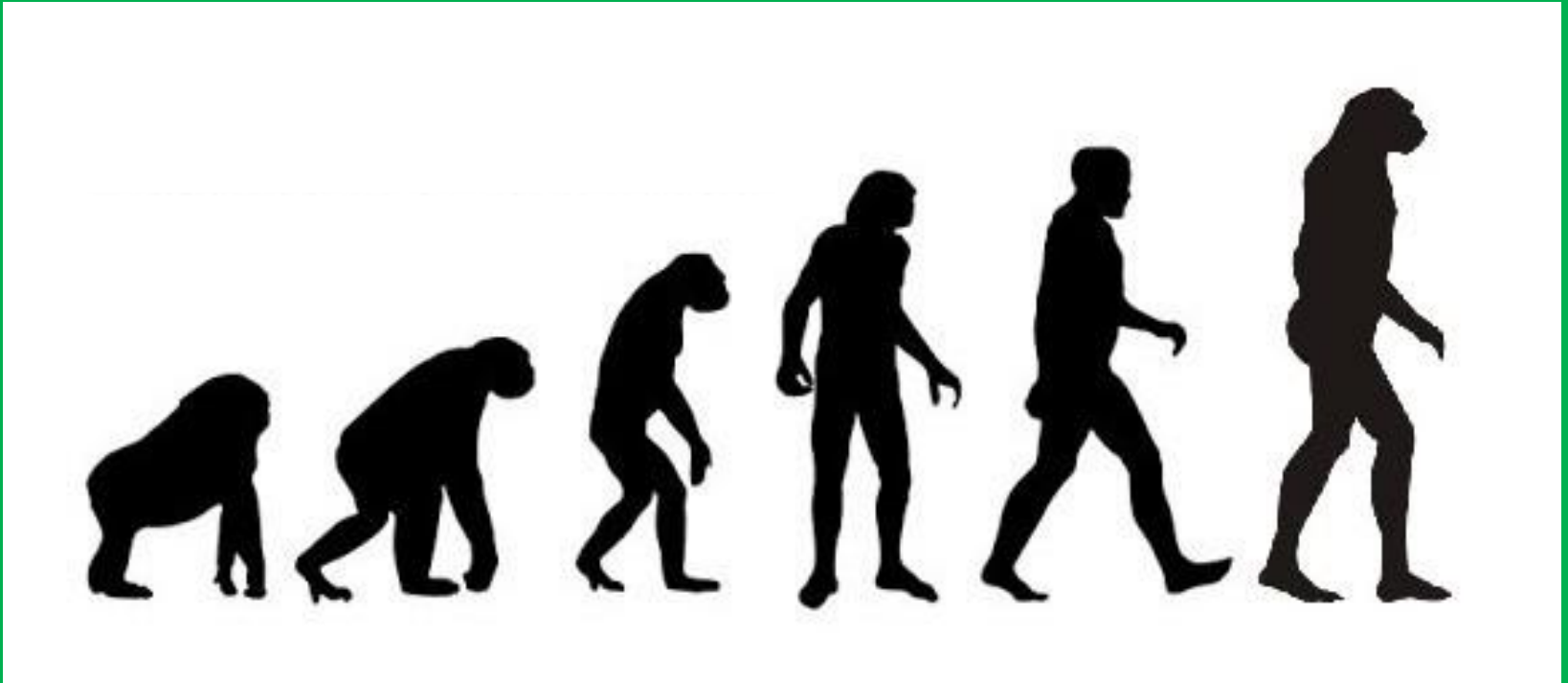

Every day, another 6,000 acres of open space are lost to development, and millions more acres are being opened to drilling, mining, and other exploitation for short-term profit by private interests.



The boreal (northern) forest is a carbon sink that traps millions of cubic feet of greenhouse gases from the atmosphere

The Canadian boreal forest, the world's largest remaining intact forest, is being lost at a rate of 1 million acres per year.



After one mass extinction there were no forests anywhere on earth for 5 million years





In 1972, a group of scientists discovered the rain that was deposited at White Mountains of New Hampshire was acidic.

There was a decrease in species diversity, an increase in community dominants, and a decrease in the food web complexity

Since 1998, Harvard University wraps the bronze and marble statues on its campus with waterproof covers every winter, in order to protect them from corrosion caused by acid rain and acid snow

Need to Restore Forests Lost to Fire

Logging interests and their political allies have sometimes claimed that cutting down more trees will reduce risk, ostensibly based on the simple calculation that it will leave less “fuel” for fires to consume.





Climate change has intensified summertime droughts, reduced the mountaintop snowpack, making fire seasons longer, and even increased lightning strikes that can trigger big fires in tinder-dry forests

In 1924 a small cabin housing a group of miners came under attack by a gang of wild “apemen.”

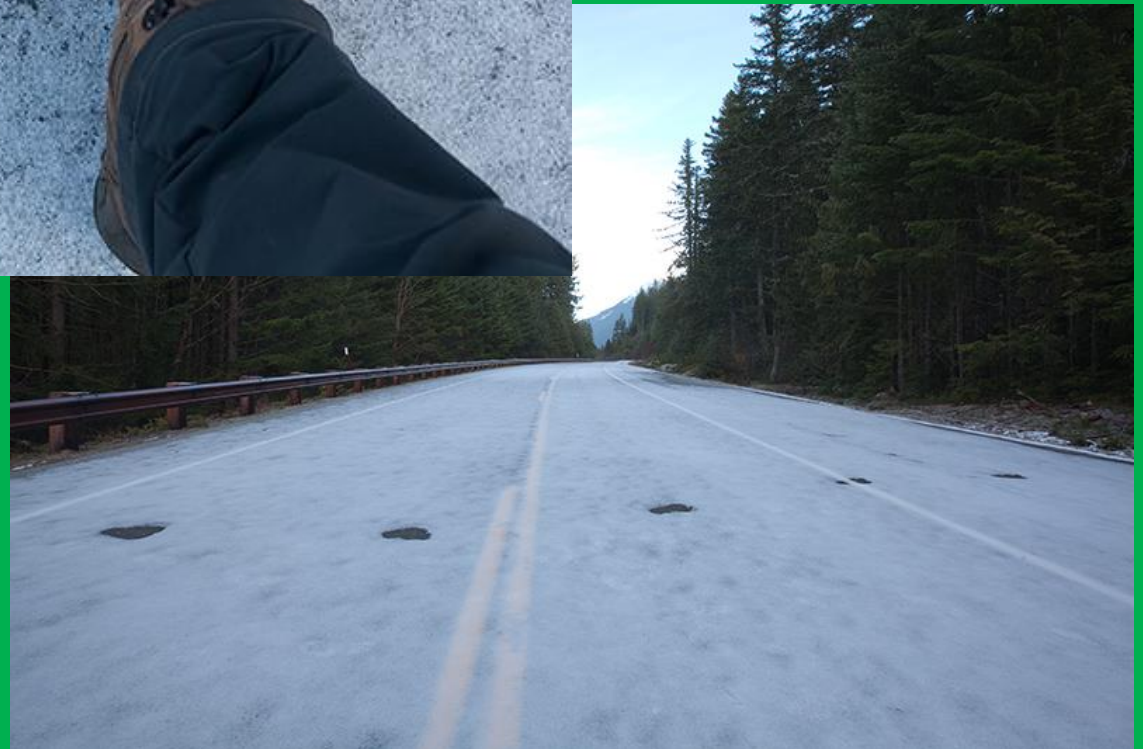

The siege continued until daybreak, when the men finally inched their way out of the cabin.

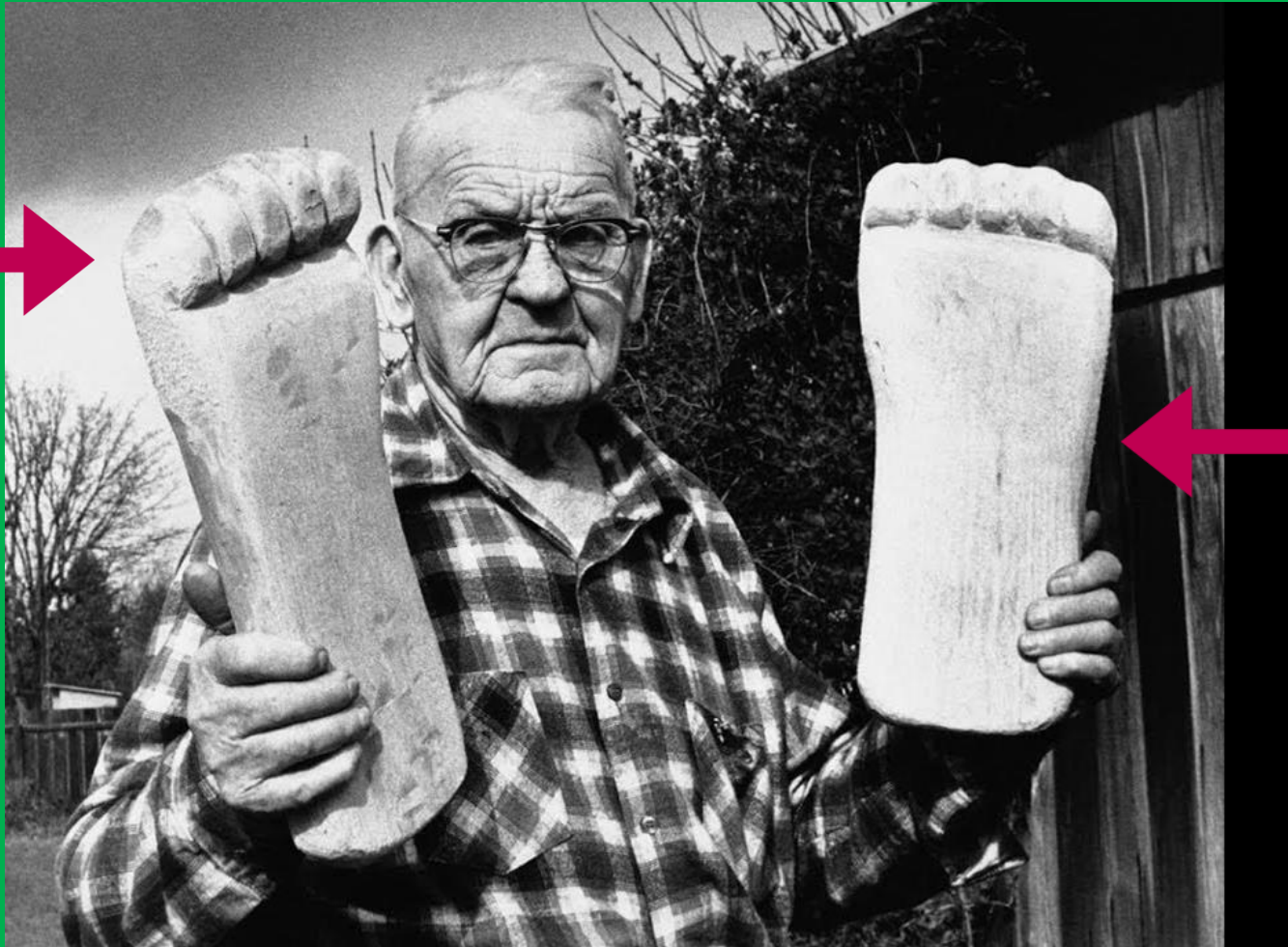

An emerging tool in conservation for monitoring past and present biodiversity, sampling at particular sites can give us a census of the diversity of life found at a location - from the soil, water and air.



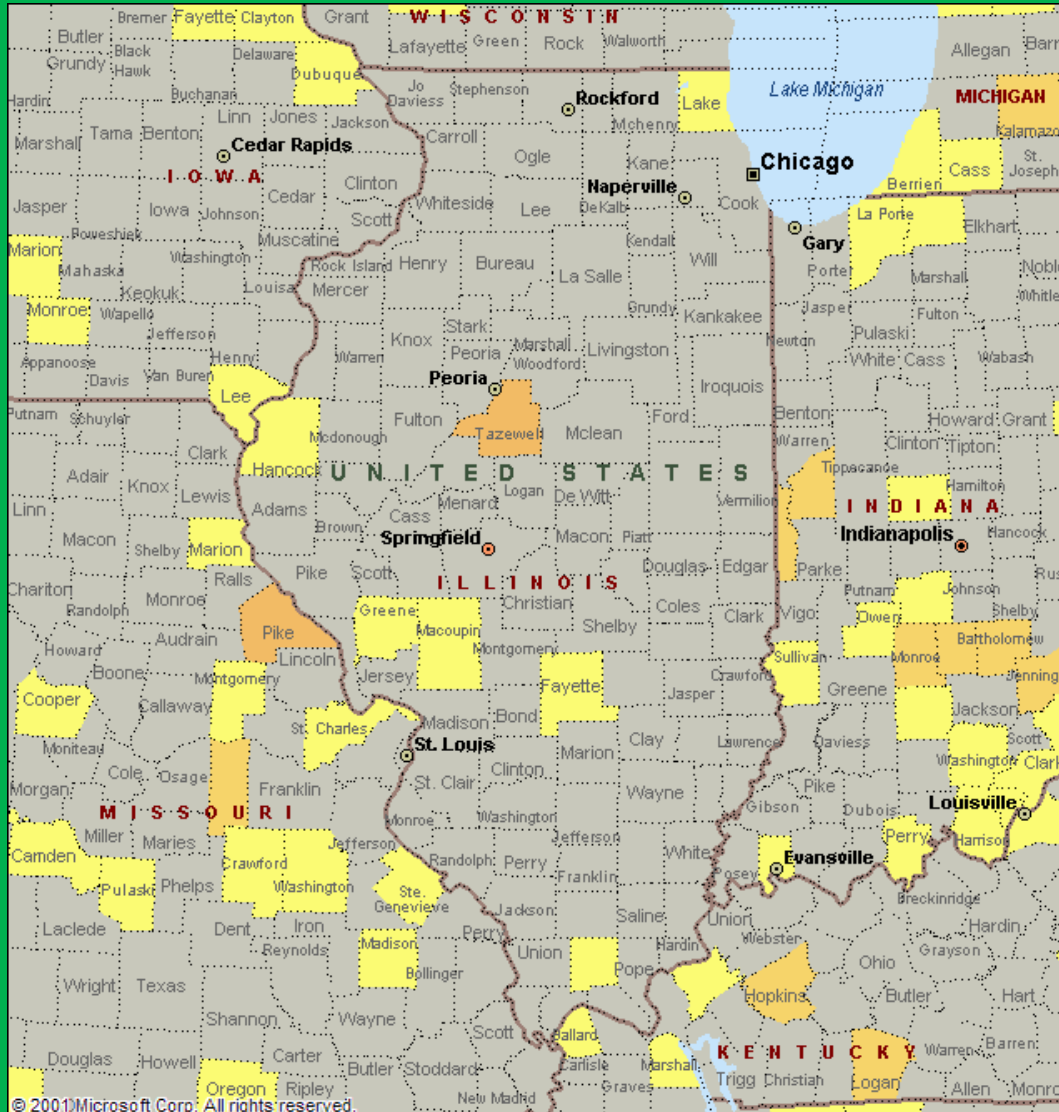
